In June 2010, under the inspiration and sacred sentiments of Shri Anantrai A. Sheth (Mumbai), the operation of Shri Kundkund-Kahan Digambar Jain Vidyarthi gruh (Kahan Shishu Vihar) was started by 'Shri Kundkund-Kahan ParmathikvTrust, Mumbai' in the holy place of meditation of the spiritual pioneer Pujya Gurudevshri Kanji Swami, the pilgrimage place Songadh. The main objective of the organization is to introduce Jain children to the true Digambar ascetic philosophy propounded by the infinite Tirthankar Bhagwan and to inculcate sanskar, moral values and sense of duty in them by sowing the seeds of Jain principles in their hearts. In addition, adequate arrangements have been made for providing children with quality, modern, and excellent secular education (grades 6 to 10 – English medium). The institution provides all the necessary facilities for the students' overall development and skill enhancement. Eligible students receive all facilities, including accommodation, meals, education, and study materials, **completely free of charge**.

Rules and Guidelines for Admission

All students and their parents seeking admission should participate in the admission process only after carefully reading, understanding and accepting the following guidelines and rules.

1. Sending the completed application form by speed post is mandatory, but merely filling the form does not guarantee admission.
2. This institution provide facilities for studing religious and secular education from class 6 to 10.
3. Religious education is based on a five-year syllabus, while secular education is provided in reputed English medium schools in Songadh.
4. From the 2026-27 session, an opportunity for CBSE English medium admission is also available, **which will be selected during the Pravesh Patrata Shivir**.
5. Only students who have secured a minimum of 75% marks in the previous class of State Board (English Medium) or a minimum of 80% marks in the CBSE Board are eligible for the Pravesh Patrata Shivir.
6. Selected students from among those who apply by the due date will be invited to Pravesh Patrata Shivir. Parents will be informed of this by phone.
7. It will be mandatory for the guardian along with the student to be present at Kahaan Shishu Vihar, Songadh on the scheduled date of the three-day Pravesh Patrata Shivir.
8. The institution will not cover any travel expenses for parents attending the Pravesh Patrata Shivir. The institution will arrange for the student's accommodation. Parents will need to arrange their own accommodation at the ATITHI NIVAS (SAMITI), whose contact details will be provided by the institution.
9. This Pravesh Patrata Shivir will include :
 - o The secular examination of the student will be conducted by the concerned school on the basis of subjects (English, Science, Maths) up to 5th standard.
 - o The examination of religious subject (Balbodh Part-1 and 2) will be conducted by the institute.
10. The basis of admission will be a comprehensive assessment of the following: Entrance Test (secular and religious), academic record of previous classes, understanding, ability and behaviour of the student. Admission will be ensured as per the merit list prepared on the basis of all these.

School allocation will be based solely on merit and the student's ability, capacity, maturity, and religious inclination. No individual, organization, or community will be allowed to exert influence, pressure, or recommendation in the admission process.

The institution reserves the right to take all decisions regarding admission.
